Walking In The Will of The Father-The Renewed Mind

1 Corinthians 9: ²⁶So I do not run **AIM**lessly; I do not box as one beating the air. ²⁷**But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified.**

1 Corinthian 10: ¹²Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall.

Luke 6: ⁴⁶ "Why do you call me 'Lord, Lord,' **and not DO what I tell you?** ⁴⁷ Everyone who comes to me and **hears my words and does them**, I will show you what he is like:

Matthew 7: ²¹ "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the **ONE WHO DOES the will of my Father who is in heaven.**

Matthew 7: ¹³ "Enter by the **NARROW GATE**. For the gate is **wide** and the way is **easy** that **leads to destruction**, and those who enter by it are **many**. ¹⁴For the gate is **narrow** and the way is **hard** that leads to life, and those who find it are **few**.

Mark 10: ⁴⁴and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all. ⁴⁵For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, **and to give his life as a ransom for MANY.**"

Daniel 12: ¹"At that time shall arise Michael, the great prince who has charge of your people. And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time. But at that time your people shall be **delivered**, everyone whose name shall be found written in the book. ²And **MANY** of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, **some** to everlasting life, and **some** to shame and everlasting contempt.

1 Corinthians 15: ²³But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, **THEN** at his coming **those who belong to Christ**. ²⁴**Then** comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power.

Matthew 25: ³⁰And cast the worthless **servant** into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'

Romans 11: ²⁸As regards the gospel, **they are enemies of God** for your sake. But as regards election, **they are beloved** for the sake of their forefathers.

²⁹For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

New Living Translation:

²⁹ For God's gifts and his call can never be withdrawn.

Ephesians 2: ¹ And you were dead in the trespasses and sins ² in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience— ³among whom **we all** once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, **and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind**.

¹⁰For we are his workmanship, **created in Christ Jesus for good works**, which God prepared beforehand, **that we should walk in them**.

Ephesians 1: ¹Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus, and are faithful in Christ Jesus:

Ephesians 1: ¹²so that **we who were the first to hope in Christ** might be to the praise of his glory.

1 Corinthians 15: ⁹For I am the least of the apostles, unworthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

¹⁰But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his **grace toward me was not in vain. On the contrary, I WORKED harder than any of them**, though it was not I, **BUT the grace of God that is with me.**

Roman 12: ¹ I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, **to present your bodies as a living sacrifice**, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. ² Do not be **conformed to this world**, **BUT be transformed by the renewal of your mind**, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. ³**For by the GRACE** given to me I say to everyone among you not to **think** of himself more highly than he ought to **think**, but to **think** with sober judgment, each according to the measure of faith that God has assigned. ⁴For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same **function**, ⁵so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. ⁶ **Having gifts that differ** according to the **GRACE given to us**, let us **USE** them: if prophecy, in proportion to our faith; ⁷if **service, in our serving**; the one who **teaches, in his teaching**; ⁸the one who **exhorts**, in his **exhortation**; the one who **contributes**, in **generosity**; the one who **leads**, with **zeal**; the one who does acts of **mercy**, with **cheerfulness**.

Romans 8: ¹²So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. ¹³For if **you** live according to the flesh **you** will die, **but if by the Spirit you put to death** the deeds of the body, **you** will live. ¹⁴**For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.**

Romans 8: ¹⁵For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" ¹⁶ The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

¹⁷and **IF** children, **then heirs**—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, **PROVIDED** we **suffer with him** in order that **WE MAY** also be glorified with him.
